PETITION FOR COMPULSORY DISCIPLINE

TO THE BOARD OF DISCIPLINARY APPEALS:

The Commission for Lawyer Discipline (hereinafter referred to as the "Commission"), brings this compulsory discipline action against attorney Sidney Powell (hereinafter called "Respondent"), showing as follows:

- 1. This action is commenced by the Commission pursuant to Part VIII of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure. The Commission is providing Respondent a copy of this Board's procedures for handling a compulsory discipline matter by attaching a copy of such procedures to this petition.
- 2. Respondent, Sidney Powell, may be served with a true and correct copy of this Petition for Compulsory Discipline and its attachments, as well as a notice of hearing, at 2911 Turtle Creek Blvd., Ste. 300, Dallas, Texas 75219-6243.
- 3. On or about October 18, 2023, Respondent was charged by Accusation (Exhibit 1) in Cause No. 23SC190370, styled *The State of Georgia v. Sidney Katherine Powell, DA #: 23DA07679*, in the Fulton Superior Court; with Count 1 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 2 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 3 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance *Petition For Compulsory Discipline*

of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 4 – Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 5 – Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; and Count 6 – Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597.

Sidney Katherine Powell, DA #: 23DA07679*, in the Fulton Superior Court; with Count 1 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 2 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 3 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 4 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; Count 5 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; and Count 6 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597; and Count 6 Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of Election Duties O.C.G.A. §§ 16-4-8 & 21-2-597.
- 5. On or about October 19, 2023, a Plea of Guilty (Exhibit 3) was entered in Indictment No. 23SC190370; styled *State of Georgia vs. Sidney Katherine Powell*, in the Superior Court of Fulton County, State of Georgia, wherein Respondent pleaded guilty to the charges.
- 6. On or about October 20, 2023, a Final Disposition Judgment (Exhibit 4, pages 5 7)¹ was entered in Criminal Action #: 23SC190370; styled *State of Georgia vs. Sidney Elizabeth*

communication with Co-Defendants, Witnesses or Media until all cases have been closed, 5)

Special Condition: Additionally, the defendant must do a full, recorded proffer with State and

provide any requested documents or evidence subject to any lawful privileges asserted in good

faith prior to entering plea.

pleaded guilty to Count 1 - Conspiracy to Commit Intentional Interference with Performance of

and correct copies of which are attached hereto.

10. Attached hereto as Exhibit 5 and made a part hereof for all intents and purposes as

if the same were copied verbatim herein is a true and correct copy of an affidavit of Amanda M.

Kates, Attorney of Record for the Commission herein, attesting to the fact that Respondent is the

same person as the person who is the subject of the Final Disposition Judgment and Amended

Final Disposition Judgment entered in the Powell criminal case. The Commission expects to

introduce the original of said affidavit at the time of hearing of this cause.

11. One or more of the above-referenced offenses to which Respondent pled guilty are

Intentional Crimes (as defined by Rule 1.06(V) of the Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure), as

each such offense is also a Serious Crime (as defined by Rule 1.06(GG), Texas Rules of

Disciplinary Procedure) that requires knowledge or intent as an essential element. Specifically, a

Serious Crime is defined as "barratry; any felony involving moral turpitude; any misdemeanor

involving theft; embezzlement, or fraudulent or reckless misappropriation of money or other

property; or any attempt, conspiracy, or solicitation of another to commit any of the foregoing

crimes." TEX. RULES DISCIPLINARY P. R. 1.06(GG).

12. Having pled guilty to one or more Intentional & Serious Crimes and having been

placed on SEVENTY TWO (72) MONTHS probation, Respondent is subject to compulsory

discipline as provided in Part VIII, Texas Rules of Disciplinary Procedure.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, the Commission prays that Respondent be

given notice of these proceedings as provided by law and, upon hearing of this matter, that the

Board enter an order imposing compulsory discipline on Respondent, and for such other and

further relief to which the Commission may be entitled to receive, including costs of court and

attorney's fees.
